The <u>Coverage to Care</u> (C2C) patient resource, <u>Telehealth: What to Know for Your Family</u>, is now available in 6 additional languages: <u>Arabic</u>, <u>Chinese</u>, <u>Haitian Creole</u>, <u>Korean</u>, <u>Russian</u>, and <u>Vietnamese</u>.
